Crime in Willow Park

ACC Reminder

Please remember to submit your plans for your properties exterior **BEFORE** you begin the work. The ACC committee works with a fast cycle-time so that we do not hold up your projects. This is especially true of new roofing requests as our homes age and roofs need replacing. Pre-approval is critical in these cases as well. These ACC rules apply to structures and fencing on your property and do NOT apply to plants and foliage. Please contact a Board of Directors member for more information or with questions; they are listed below.



Boats/RV's/Trailer

Please remember that your trailers and boats and such need to be stored either behind your approved fence, in your garage, or outside of the neighborhood. These objects are only to visit your driveway for **brief periods (1-2 days)** during the recreation season. Contact the Board if you would like to request to keep on in the street for longer than 2 days.



Barking Dogs

Please remember that barking dogs are a nuisance. Now that the weather is getting better, more folks are opening windows and now hear all the dogs left outside to bark. If your neighbor's dog is a problem, please contact the offending dog OWNER first. If the homeowner does NOT cooperate and bring the dog indoors, then contact Animal Control at 253-931-3062 or email info@auburnvallehhs.org The WPHOA is not in the animal control business.
